Dear HRP AC members,

There are two openings for new members on the Advisory Council. Please share this email and spread the word.

The state law that created the Hudson River Park (the Hudson River Park Act) (HRPA) also created the Hudson River Park Advisory Council (HRP AC) to provide advice and recommendations to the Board of the Hudson River Park Trust on all matters regarding the planning, design, construction, and operation of the Hudson River Park (the Park).

Up to 27 members of the 51-member HRP AC represent local community, park, environmental, civic, labor, and business organizations with an interest in or relationship to the Park (the other 24 members include elected officials, their appointees and community board representatives identified by the HRPA).

To ensure balance and diversity of membership, our bylaws state that no more than 20% of the full Council membership shall be composed of Park tenants. Diversity and balanced participation is also promoted through assessing geographic or functional representation by the different neighborhoods and interest groups in relation to the Park.
